On Saturday, at 10 a.m. the workshops will cover the topics of peer pressure, drugs, alcohol, sex and the single and married couples.

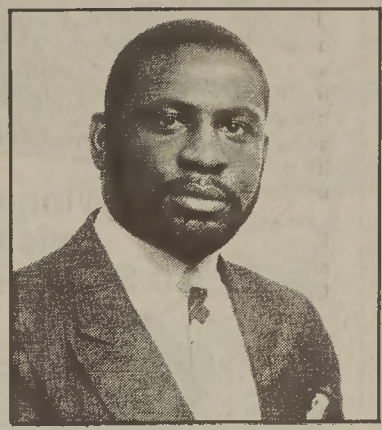
There will be a special concert on Saturday evening at 7 p.m. The general public age 16 and up is invited to attend.

Also on Sunday, August 20th at 2:30 p.m. the Salem Men of Armour will have their annual day.

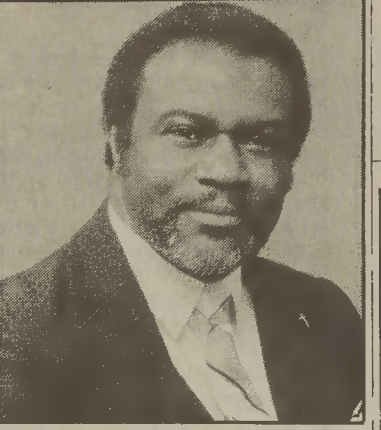

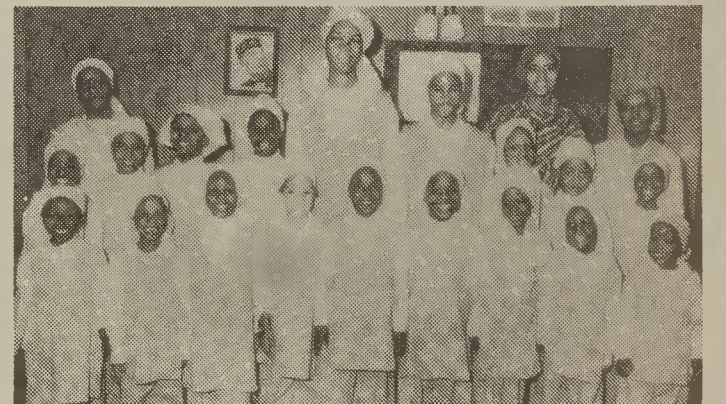

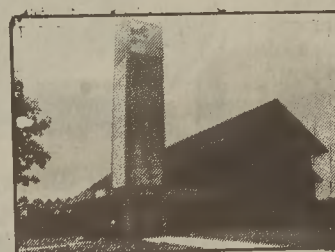
