

# Davidson's 1989 Basketball Year

The Davidson Wildcats' 1989-90 basketball schedule includes several showcase events and campus games against two Atlantic Coast Conference teams for the first time in several decades.

Davidson will be playing its first season under Coach Bob McKillop and moves into the Belk Arena in the Baker Sports Complex. The Belk Arena seats 6,000 for basketball and the Wildcats' dedication game will

be December 2 against Terry Holland's Virginia Cavaliers. Holland will become the Wildcats' Director of Athletics next spring. He was a standout player for Davidson in the 1960s and was head coach for five seasons in the 1970s.

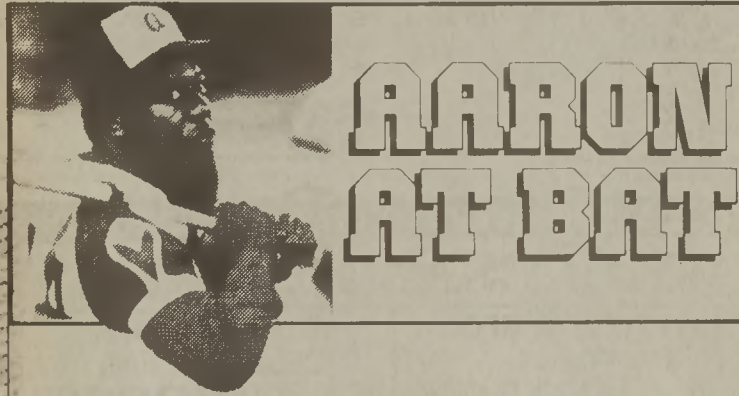
Virginia's appearance on campus will be the first by an ACC team since Davidson upset Wake Forest in Lefty Driesell's first year as head coach in 1960. Additionally, Duke plays at Davidson December 21. It will be the

first trip to Davidson in 37 years for the Blue Devils.

The Cats play teams from nearly every major conference in the country. In addition to Duke and Virginia of the Atlantic Coast Conference at home, they play Wake Forest on the road. Other opponents from national conferences include St. John's of the Big East, UNCC of the Sun Belt, South Carolina of the Metro, Iowa State of the Big Eight, Miami of Ohio of the Mid-American Conference, UNC-

Wilmington and William and Mary of the Colonial Athletic Association and five games against Southern Conference teams. Major independent Miami of Florida plays in Belk Arena.

"I'm very excited about the schedule and know that our players and the Davidson community share this enthusiasm," McKillop says. "This will be an outstanding inaugural year for the Belk Arena. As a program we are thrilled with the challenges ahead."



## AARON AT BAT

### A Shoestring Catch

One of the most exciting things to watch in baseball is an outfielder running at full speed, then leaping to make a catch just before a dying fly ball hits the grass. Why is it that later in the game the same player might pull up and play a fly ball on the first bounce?

It isn't that the player has lost his nerve. Playing the bounce was probably a smart play. Depending on the situation, it may have been a smarter play than the shoestring catch. And that's the key to the whole question of how to play a fly ball that may or may not be catchable. It all depends on the situation.

Say you are in the later part of a game and the score is tied. If you dive and miss, the ball could easily get behind you, and the runner will make second base with little trouble and might get all the way to third base. Now a routine fly ball becomes a sacrifice fly that scores the go-ahead run. That kind of mistake is one the manager will have trouble forgiving. It's better to play the bounce and keep the runner at first base.

In the first few innings you will, quite naturally, take more of a chance than in the ninth inning. But there are other factors to consider as well. You certainly wouldn't play the same way in the Astrodome as you would on natural grass. On artificial turf if you drop a shoestring catch, it's more likely to bounce a long distance and result in a triple or an inside-the-park home run.

So it depends on the score of the game, where you are playing and who the base runners are. If the batter is fast, or if there is a good runner already on base, that speed has to be taken into consideration.

If you get to the ninth inning leading by a run, the one thing the manager doesn't want to happen is to have a ball hit over an outfielder's head. The word is "give them the single but don't give them the double." If you are at the stadium, look into the dugout and you'll probably see someone waving a towel. That means play back and keep all balls in front of you.

The infielders also adjust in this situation. Early in the game, the third baseman played "off-the-line," a few steps from the foul line towards the center of the field. In the ninth inning, he will be "guarding the line" because a ball hit down the line is just about an automatic double.

This is all just good, basic baseball. And it's second nature, or should be, with most players. **ll**

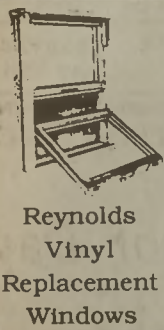

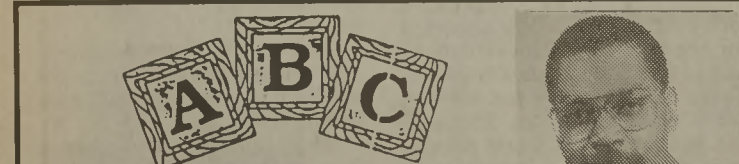
