

Quincy Jones III Arrested In UCLA Shooting

 LOS ANGELES (AP) --- UCLA fraternities are reviewing security procedures in the wake of a shooting at a weekend party and the arrest of Quincy Delight Jones III, son of Grammy Award winning record producer Quincy Jones.

No one was wounded in the Saturday brawl.

Charges had not been filed as of Thursday afternoon against the 20-year-old Jones, who was arrested Wednesday night and booked for investigation of assault with a deadly weapon. He was released after posting \$2,000 bail.

A message left with Jones' publicist was not immediately returned.

cial activities," said Gary Hobart, president of the Interfraternity Council, the ruling body of the 24 UCLA fraternities. Frat houses are privately owned.

Four other men were arrested early Saturday in connection with the incident, but were released. No charges were filed against them.

Witnesses described Jones as the alleged gunman.

The elder Jones, 56, has produced albums for numerous artists, including Michael Jackson's hit "Thriller." The Grammy Award-winner also composed the scores for such films as "In Cold Blood" and "The Color Purple."

Mike Botula, a district attorney's spokesman, said the office had not yet received the case from Los Angeles Police Department detectives. UCLA police Lt. Alan Cueba said investigators planned to file a felony complaint.

Campus police broke up the party at the University of California, Los Angeles, fraternity Saturday morning after neighbors complained that a crowd of youths was making too much noise.

As partygoers dispersed, about a dozen members of a neighboring fraternity engaged in a fight and two shots were fired, campus police Chief John C. Barber said.

Police searching Jones' Venice home discovered a nine-round semiautomatic handgun with two bullets missing, Barber said.

Jones, 20, is not a student at UCLA but apparently attended the party, held by a local high school and junior college that had rented the Sigma Phi Epsilon house for the night.

In response to the incident, campus police have increased patrols of fraternity row. Some fraternities are reviewing policies regarding renting frat houses to outside interests.

"The UCLA fraternity system will be looking seriously at some measures to prevent outsiders from coming to our facilities and causing problems at so-
