

## • June 23

King and other black leaders meet with President Eisenhower.

# • September

King's book "Stride Toward Freedom: The Montgomery Story" is published.

# 1959

## February

Martin and Coretta King spend a month in India, as guests of Prime Minister Nehru, studying Gandhi's techniques of nonviolence.

## 1960

· January 24 King becomes co-pastor, with his father, of Ebenezer Baptist Church in Atlanta, Georgia.

## 1962

#### • September 20

James Meredith, a black, makes an attempt to enroll at the University of Mississippi. He is ultimately enrolled by Supreme Court order, and is escorted onto the campus by U.S. marshals.

#### • October 16

King meets with President Kennedy in a one hour White House conference.



## • April 16

King writes the "Letter from Birmingham Jail" while imprisoned for demonstrating against the segregation of eqting facilities in that city.

#### • August 28

King delivers the "I Have a Dream" speech at the Lincoln Memorial during the March on Washington, the first large integrated protest march.
