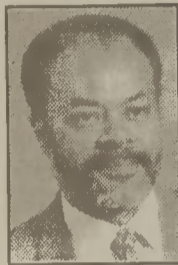

## Anderson preaches first sermon

Charlotte native Edward Moses Anderson Sr. preached his initial sermon last Sunday at New Ford Baptist Church in Danburg, Ga. defense, she says, is to prevent violent episodes from escalating.

"I want women to know that once abuse has started, it will almost always continue," Nicholson said. Women need to get help in the beginning of the cycle of abuse. There are three phases of the cycle: the build up, the explosion, and the honeymoon.

"An abusive partner isolates a woman financially, he intimidates her physically, he threatens to hurt the children, or he sexually demands things of her," Nicholson said. "These things happen before he ever hits her."

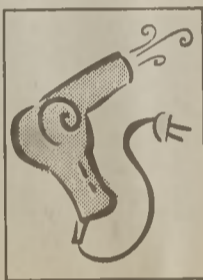

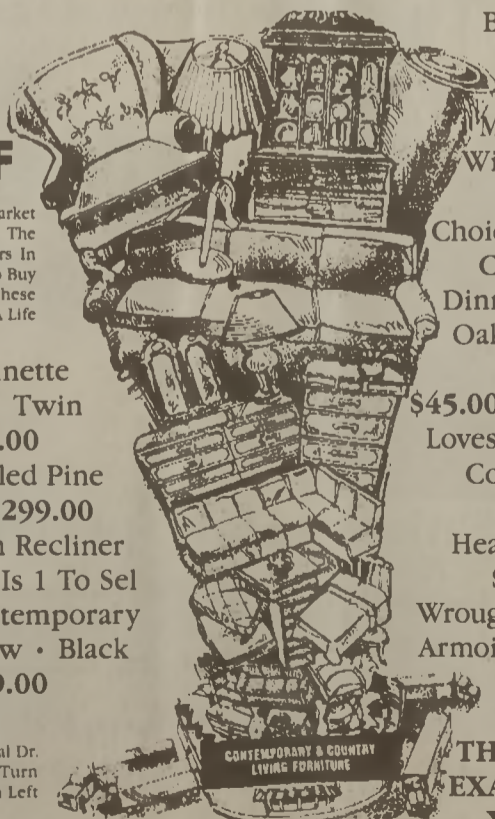
