Pastor Mack is married to Connie, his soul mate, and they have four children.

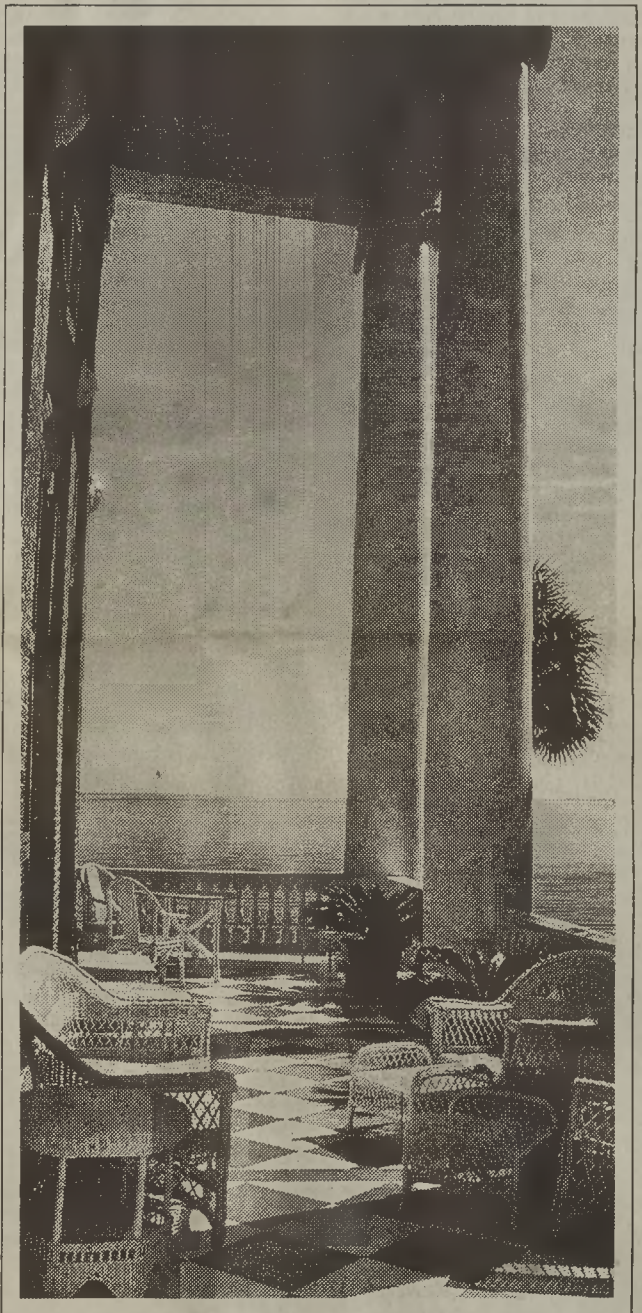
