Both expressed gratitude for the positive reaction of many of their relatives and friends. Marcus' mother has even expressed an interest in NOI.

"My cousins told me that I sounded like I had something in me that I didn't have before," Marcus said. "My mom has been reading some of the books also."

"Actually," James said, "I have only two living friends, one of them is incarcerated.

He loves the minister and the tapes. They know I have always had the faith and the belief - I just didn't want to do any work. They saw that the faith that I had I have just put it to work."

Both men see the occasional naysayers as proof what they are doing is right.

"Trials are ordained for the believers, we learn that from Job," James said. "It is what we have to be prepared for."
