## Mattox Yadkin 2A player of year

"He's been to everything that we've had in the past three years. Even if he has been sick, he came and sat on the sidelines. He's really dedicated to the game and has worked to make himself better."


Falcons sophomore Bryson Goodlett joined Mattox on the 2A Yadkin Valley team.
