

When the Holy Spirit awakened met to my lost condition (I.k. 19:10, Eph. 2:1), I looked around me and made this statement: "No one around me is saved, and I've never been to the funeral of a saved person." I know that makes multitudes of you mad. It just shows that you are a total stranger to Holy Spirit Conviction. It is just the bilnd leading the blind, and they both will fall into the pit of Hell.


