 sion our fellowship with them on that day," said Sandra Williams, Walls Memorial's Christian education director. "Kids really need a positive situation and they need to know that there is a higher spiritual being that they need in their lives."

This year's themes are: "P.A.S.S. - Parents And Students Succeeding" and "The Paths to Success are God, Education and Fellowship." There will be entertainment, games for kids, food and school supplies. Free to the public.

In 2002, the National Council of Churches created a program that urged pastors to support public education, noting that 90 percent of children in the U.S. attend public schools.

Bob Edgar, the NCC's general secretary, said "public schools are our nation's largest social institution."

Edgar says that failing schools are a reflection of society failing by not providing them with tools they need to succeed.

"Our biggest concern," said Jan Resseger, minister for public education and a member of the NCC, "is to work for excellence for all school children in the country."

Resseger said local members of the faith community can help the cause of educa-

tion by contacting their congressional representatives and telling them how No Child Left Behind is affecting teachers and students. Resseger said though the legislation is billed as something that fits all communities, it does not.


"We're really hoping that as the school year begins that local people will tell that story," she said.
