started operating the Good Shepherd Catholic Mission in the otherwise all-Protestant and almost all-black community of Mosses.
Now she lives in Mosses with retired 74-year-old Sister Frances Schaeffer. Her work is part of the ministry of The Edmondite Missions in Selma, which has been operating outreach missions in Alabama's Black Belt—

a mostly poor region named for its rich soil since 1937.
Chaput, who belongs to the Sisters of Charity, BVM, of Dubuque, Iowa, said she was struck by the vast needs the first time she visited Mosses—only about 35 miles southwest of Montgomery on the map but a world away when it comes to the lifestyle.
The 2000 Census listed Lowndes County as one of the 100 poorest counties in America.
