I praise the Lord for saving me by His Grace, redeeming by His Blood. And I am not ashamed of the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ because the Gospel is the power of God unto Salvation. It is the power of God unto my salvation. Can you say that along with me? Are you praising the Lord for redeeming you by His Blood? As I talk with preachers and Bible teachers I don't find them praising the Lord, and Christ is not a Living Reality to their hearts. And they are not looking for the soon Coming of Christ. A preacher's wife told me just recently that her husband never talks to her about the Lord. At this time I feel led to bring another study from the Word of God on the subject: "GOD'S ORDER." Worldwide there is nothing but rebellion and violence throughout the earth. And surely, "...for all flesh had corrupted his (God's) way upon the earth." (Gen. 6:12) Practically every church member will acknowledge that the world is filled with violence and corruption. And many of you will ask why. There is a small number of us who can answer your question from the Word of God. But when we try to tell you what is wrong, you will not have it! I've heard the statement much lately, "What is wrong with the people? They have just gone." Will you just tune your ears to listen to "thus saith" the Lord?
