

ies. Simcha Jacobovici, the Toronto filmmaker who directed the film, said that a name on one of the ossuaries."Mari-amene" —offers evidence that the tomb is that of Jesus and his family. In early Christian texts, "Mariamene" is the name of Mary Magdalene, he said. The very fact that Jesus had an ossuary would contradict the Christian belief that he was resurrected and ascended to heaven. Most Christians believe Jesus' body spent three days at the site of the Church of the Holy Sepulcher in Jerusalem's old City. 
