where Sharpton would visit or identify his escort. Salt Lake City is the world headquarters of the Mormon church, with a temple and other properties covering several downtown blocks.

A telephone message

seeking comment from Sharpton's office was not immediately returned. He was expected to broadcast his radio show from Salt Lake City.

After his comments about Romney, the Pentecostal minister said he didn't mean to imply that Mormons don't believe in God and claimed the remark was distorted for political purposes.

During a phone call to

apologize to two church elders, Sharpton indicated that he'd like to visit and learn more about the church, Otterson said.

Church leaders consider the flap over Sharpton's comments closed, he said.

Officially, the church will not comment on Romney's campaign and maintains a position of political neutrality.
