DRANK OCEANS OF BOOZE.

Venerable Western Hero Has Absorbed 12,775 Gallons of Firewater.

Although he says he consumed in his life 12,775 gallons of alcohol, D. L. Osborn, "D. S. G.," has lived to the ripe old age of eighty-six, and is a shining example of a cure made by the Christian assembly holding forth at Arlington park, out near 4th and Emerson avenues.

A few months ago, according to the story, this marvel of alcoholic consumption was discovered in Kansas City by Rev. G. Frederick Fink, the director of the assembly, and high priest of the sect. Osborn was then using crutches, and was carrying about with him some of the 12,000 odd gallons of whisky. In short, he was about to die. The hands were laid on him, and lo! there was nothing more doing for him in "booze consumption."

The 12,775 gallons of alcohol is some "booze," and in order to get that much under his belt, Elder Osborn had to start early, which he did, about the time he was sixteen years old. He drank half a gallon a day up until four months ago, and he is now 86 years old. The alcohol consumed by this one man would run a 10-horsepower automobile three and one-half times around the earth, with some to spare.

The "D. S. G.," following Elder Osborn's name interpreted stands for "Drunkard Saved by Grace."

Mr. Osborn tells all about the quantities of rum he has stowed away at every meeting. The meeting opened with three cheers for Jesus, and the aggregation might easily have been taken for college football enthusiasts. The cheering continued throughout the meeting, and whenever one of the speakers said anything that pleased his auditors, deep murmurings of approval went up from the assembled people.
