Trial of the \$100,000 Pearce damage suit is now in its second week in Wake County Superior Court and it is thought that it will not be finished before the end of the week.

Mrs. Allie May Pearce is seeking \$100,000 from the Izenhour Brick Co., Sanford, for the death of her husband, John Frederick Pearce, in an automobile crash on November 19, 1928.

Another suit for \$100,000 is awaiting completion of the Pearce action, that of Thomas Vincl, Jr., who was riding with Pearce at the time of the accident and alleges that he was severely injured.
