### Menu Maker's Mainstay-Home Canned Green Beans



Green beans are a nourishing supply for your family by canning them in your own kitchen. Select fresh beans and be sure to wash them thoroughly before he pods are broken or cut. The short fuzz or nap on the pods holds dust and possibly bacteria, yeasts or moulds which may cause spoilage. After

washing the beans, string, and break or cut them into two-inch pieces. Boil five minutes and pack into hot Ball jars. Add one tea-spoon salt to each quart. Cover with water in which the beam were cooked. Process beans with small, young pods 35 minutes and those with large pods 55 min-utes at ten pounds pressure.
