We have sometimes heard in North Carolina the sarcastic remark, "It is against the law to commit murder in Virginia." This is usually after some flagrant acquittal in this State or some conviction in Virginia of a criminal whom everybody knows to be guilty.

Virginia is noted for her enforcement of the law, and her method of sometimes selecting jurors from adjoining counties probably has much to do with her success. The passage of a bill through the North Carolina General Assembly granting permission to select jurors from adjoining counties places this State upon a more equal footing.
