NEW NORFOLK SOUTHERN AGRICULTURAL AGENT Norfolk, Va., May 4.—Willard T. Kyzer, of Lexington, S. C., has been appointed agricultural agent for the Norfolk Southern system, effective May 1. Mr. Kyzer arrived in the city today to take up his duties and will have his headquarters here.

The office of agricultural agent is a new one recently created by the Norfolk Southern Railroad, the work of this department being previously handled by the industrial agent, which office was abolished at the death of B. E. Rice in October, 1915. All strictly industrial matters will be handled in the freight traffic department.

Mr. Kyzer will go over the Norfolk Southern system in order to familiarize himself with its general layout and then he will organize his department here where his headquarters will be. His work will be teaching more productive methods of farming as well as securing settlers.
