Calgary, Alberta, Nov. 4.—Vegemans dynamited the Merchants' Bank here early this morning, escaping with \$25,000.

BAD WRECK ON THE NORFOLK-SOUTHERN

Wilson, N. C., Nov. 6.—Five persons were killed and seventeen injured when a Norfolk Southern train ran into an open cut at Zebulon twenty miles from Wilson, Saturday evening. The persons are believed to be buried in the wreckage. The conductor of the train, C. A. Sallinger, a resident of Raleigh, one negro woman and three negro men killed.

Mrs. Virginia Williams, of Raleigh, was perhaps fatally hurt. An artery in her neck was severed. Among those injured were: J. E. Crute, of Wilson; Jesse E. Williams and W. B. Briggs, former postmaster at Raleigh.

DOLLAR SUPPLANTS POUND STERLING IN THE ORIENT

(By United Press)

Tokio, Nov. 6.—Once more the American gold dollar has supplanted the British pound sterling. Abandoning a custom that has been observed by shipping companies in the Far East for more than forty years, the Canadian Pacific Ocean Service, Ltd., the Toyo Kisen Kaisha and the Pacific Mail Steamship company agreed today on a uniform schedule of passenger rates, which provide that all passages are to be paid on the basis of American gold dollars.

In the past passenger fares on boats bound from the Orient to America have been paid on the basis of pounds sterling. Heretofore passage on liners bound from Vancouver, Victoria or San Francisco to the Far East has been paid in gold dollars, but passage on east bound steamers has been payable in British money.

MANY PERISHED IN STEAMER COLLISION

London, Nov. 4.—It is feared that 200 persons perished in the collision between the steamers Connemara and Retriever in the Irish Sea today. One survivor has been found.
