(Continued from page 1) a whack at a clump of rushes with his oar or pole and a marsh hen arises for a slow and erratic flight to some nearby point. If the sportsman knows his business, there is a bang and the course of the boat is deflected to pick up the victim before continuing its progress through the marshes with a full bag limit of marsh hens as the goal.

**Other Game Abundant**  
The fields and forests of Brunswick are abundantly stocked with game birds, everything from wild turkey on down. The sportsmen after quail or partridges generally return home with a full limit during the hunting season. Many sportsmen from other states come to Brunswick for quail shooting, and the fellow with an especially good bird dog is a member of the tribe whom the others delight to honor.

In this conjunction it may be said that Southport has more than its average quota of good birds dogs. Many of our sportsmen are not satisfied with just one animal, they have two. Sometimes they boast possession of three. This and that bird dog and his wonderful quality as a hunter begins to be an absorbing subject for discussion at all little gatherings several weeks before the beginning, and all during the hunting season.

## Deer and Bear

There are a great many deer and bear in the forests of Brunswick. The bear is not, naturally, rated very high as a game animal worth hunting. But the deer furnish royal sport until the hunter gets the limit allowed by law.

Squirrels (fox and cat) are numerous in all our woodland tracts and it is a poor hunter who misses making the full daily limit allowed by law. Raccoons, 'opossums and rabbits are very numerous. Few care to hunt rabbit, but the coons and 'opossums are the attraction on many a nocturnal journey through the woods.

## Plenty Of Foxes

It can probably be truthfully said that there are more foxes per square mile in Brunswick than in a like area in any other county in the state. Brunswick has about 80 per cent of its total land area in woodland, that is fields, woods and swamps that are uncultivated.

In these areas the fox roams by the hundreds and affords the incentive for many a merry chase by a lusty pack of hounds. Many sportsmen from the mountains of western North Carolina and other states have an annual habit of coming to Brunswick for two weeks or more of fox hunting. They generally bring many fine fox hounds with them on these trips and go home with their cars decorated with the brushes of foxes that these animals ran down.

## Improved Status Shown In State

Raleigh, Aug. 9.—Improving employment conditions, in industry and business, are being reflected almost daily in the requests of employers in the North Carolina for more blanks for making their quarterly reports of payments to individual employees for the second quarter in 1937, Chairman Charles G. Powell, of the Unemployment Compensation Commission, reports.

Blanks are sent out quarterly for these reports in accordance with the numbers of employees reported for last year, with additions for normal increases.

The many calls for additional blanks indicate increases in numbers of employees over 1936 and the first quarter of 1937.

## Call On Employers For Payroll Items

Raleigh, Aug. 9.—Notices and demands for payments of payroll contributions have been sent out to 135 North Carolina employers by the State Unemployment Compensation Commission. Unless the employers protest the payments, request hearings on whether or not they are due to pay, or pay the amounts, they are certified to the clerk of court and copies sent to the sheriff for execution as of judgment. Executions have been served on seven employers. Usually when execution is started by the sheriff, the employer pays the contribution and accumulated costs.
