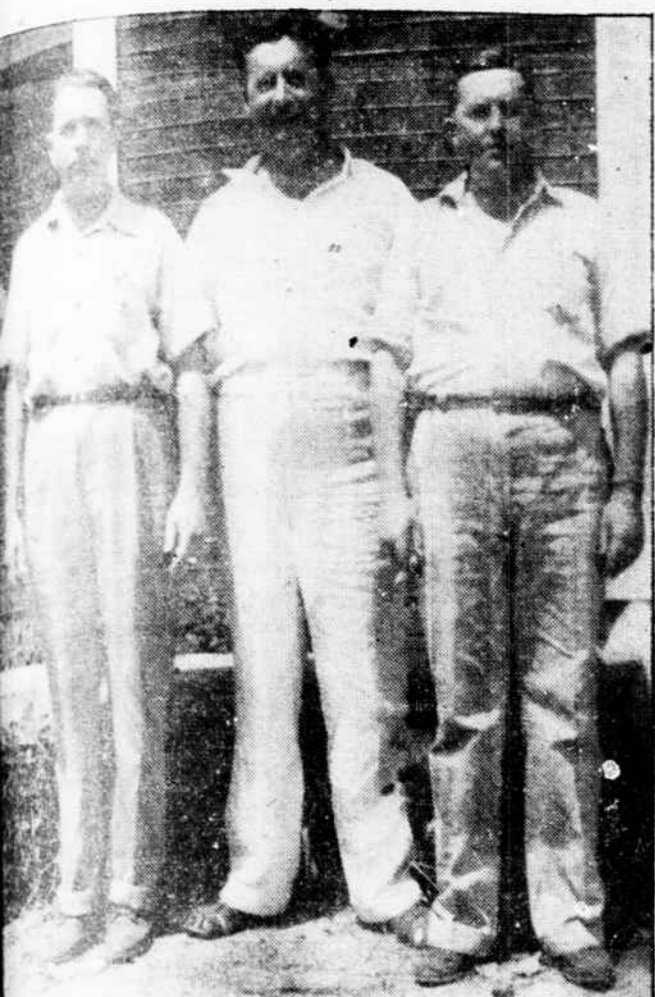


THE BIG THREE AT BIG 3

Garrell Back At Big Three

Alton Garrell, Veteran Tobaccoist, Will Again Operate The Big 3 Warehouse in Tabor City

The greater part of warehouse throughout these Eastern "tobacco" have few competitors other than their own. B. A. Garrell, proprietor of the Big 3 Warehouse in Tabor City, operating a tobacco business is only another of the many who are working for Tabor City. B. Alton Garrell is

known as a produce buyer, and as well, as a tobacco warehouseman. He was born and reared in Tabor City and has been associated with his home town market since he was 14 years old.

Throughout the year Mr. Garrell carries on business transactions with the farmers. He hardly had the time to complete produce market transactions this year before the tobacco market was almost ready to open. Soon after the tobacco market has seen another season under the mill, Mr. Garrell begins buying sweet potatoes, then strawberries, beans, Irish potatoes and other kind of produce that farmers may bring to market. Consequently, he is engaged in business transactions with farmers almost 12 months out of the year.

Mr. Garrell is the sole proprietor of the Big 3 Warehouse,

but each year his establishment is known for employing one of the finest group of workmen in the belt.

Floor manager at the Big 3 will be Mr. Garrell's brother, Otus Garrell, who, incidentally, worked with him this past season on the produce market.

The Big 3 Warehouse underwent an enlargement program last summer, extending the floor space some 20,000 feet, giving the warehouse a floor space of 50,000 square feet. This floor space will help house the thousands of pounds of golden leaf that his farmer friends will roll into the Big 3 this season.

The Big 3 Warehouse boasts an improved lighting system that makes it one of the best lighted houses in the belt.

Mr. Garrell, his personnel, and the Big 3 Warehouse stand in readiness to welcome their farmer friends and the 1942 tobacco season.
