Ice has formed on puddles of still water in this county only three times this winter. Each time it has been very little thicker than the sheet of newspaper and was all melted by 10 o'clock the morning. About the same number of frosts that might be described as killing have occurred. There has been nothing approaching frozen ground or any accumulation of snow, so far as Brunswick county is concerned.

Each week the State News Bureau in Raleigh is sending off the big out-of-state daily newspapers something in the way of interesting or odd stories

about things in Brunswick county. Such stories are read by hundreds of thousands of people and create in the minds of many such readers a desire to sometime visit this county. For the past few years he has been operating a small fish market at Shallotte, filling in the time while waiting for customers by sharpening and setting crosscut saws. Many of the good folks of the Shallotte community go out of their way to take their saws to Irving to be sharpened, and this is as it should be. Others might well go out of their way to give him something to do.

Last week Representative Odell

Williamson stated in an interview that he planned to introduce a bill providing for a closed commercial season on oysters in Brunswick county. Such action, he said, was dependent on what the folks who engage in oyster-fishing wanted him to do. Seen again this week, the representative stated that all who want to see him Friday and Saturday were in favor of the closed season. The movement to have the closed season is inspired by the fact that the neighboring state of South Carolina has a closed season on commercial oyster-fishing. As a result hundreds of thousands of bushels of Brunswick oysters are hauled away into South Carolina and other states. The local oyster beds are being stripped bare at many points along the coast.

The Shallotte branch of the Waccamaw Bank and Trust company will be moving into its new brick home the last of this week. During the little over six months that this bank has been serving the Shallotte section of Brunswick county it has established itself as an institution for good that performs a real service. The folks in the lower part of the county realize the value of the banking service that they now have and expressions of appreciation are heard freely. Along with the appreciation of the bank itself, there is appreciation and congratulations towards R. D. White, who constructed the splendid brick building in which the bank and the Shallotte Soda Shop are both located.
