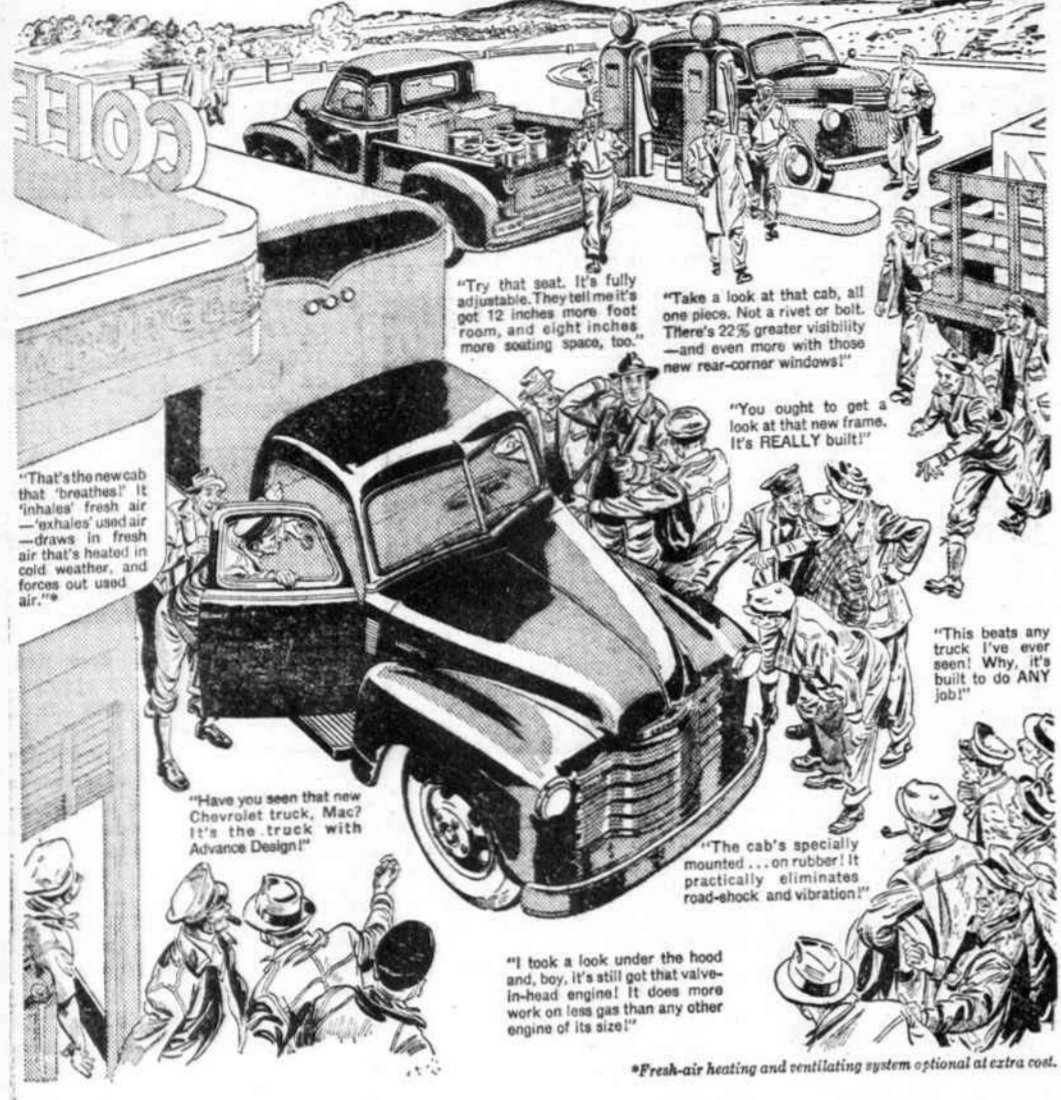

Gas Station Operator Shot, Robbed Of \$25,000

CONWAY, S. C. Nov. 10—(AP) Sheriff C. E. Sasser said today that Clayton Hall, 55, found shot to death 30 yards from his filling station and near his hog pen, was the victim of thieves who stole more than \$25,000. Hall who operated the station and a tourist camp at Crescent Beach, was discovered yesterday with 12-gauge shotgun slugs imbedded in his back. Sasser theorized Hall was on his way to feed his hogs when he was slain.

The sheriff said a meat can containing \$25,000 was missing from Hall's establishment, in addition to a wallet supposedly containing between \$500 and \$1,000. However, an ammunition box containing \$17,000 was untouched, the sheriff reported.
