...that Bobby Sellers has made a complete confession, admitting that he was in the car and that he was driving at the time of the fatal wreck.
...made a complete confession to Patrolman Cummings...
...Chomer John G. Caison, who was with him when the arrest was made in Jacksonville. He re-

ported that he had joined Murrell at the Bill Reynolds Service Station on the night of the fatal wreck, and that the two came to Southport to attend a dance at the Community Building. After the dance, he said that they had started toward Supply, but stopped at Garner's place, where Rufus Sellers joined them. Bobby Sellers said that he was driving the car, and that Rufus Sellers placed both his feet on top of the foot he had on the accelerator. He declared that he reached down to free the pressure, and that when he did the car went out of control, resulting in the fatal wreck.

Officers say that from the first Murrell, third man in the car and owner of the vehicle, has refused to shed any light on the situation, clinging to his story that he cannot remember anything that happened.
