He has been a firm believer in the principle of orderly planning from the beginning.

The cost of the work constructed was as follows:

Later distribution system, \$85,000; sewer lines, \$200,000; and sewage treatment plant, \$130,000.

The water project was constructed by the Ziegler-Cline Construction Company of Fayetteville; the sewer lines by the Nello L. Teer Company, Durham; and the sewage treatment plant by the Lee Construction Corp., Charlotte. Paul G. Nystrom was Resident Engineer.

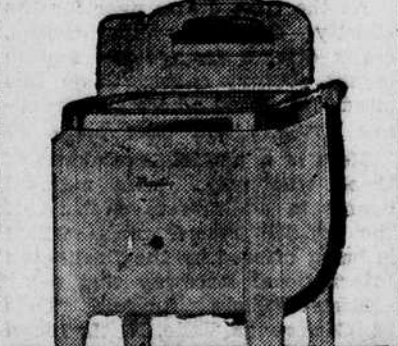

Sealed proposals will be received by the Board of Education of Brunswick County in the office of the Board of Southport, North Carolina, until 2:00 P. M. o'clock Monday, September 4, 1950, for the erection and completion of a gymnasium at Southport, N. C., and a gymnasium at Waccamaw high school, Ash N. C.

Plans and specifications for the proposed work will be on file at the office of the Board of Education, Southport, N. C. One copy of plans and specifications may be obtained by licensed contractors upon written request to Leslie N. Honey, Architect, Wilmington, N. Said bid deposit may, at the discretion of the Board, be retained in event of failure of the successful bidder to execute the contract within 10 days after the award of bid to give satisfactory surety bond as required.

General Contractors are notified that an Act to Regulate the Practice of General Contracting, ratified by the General Assembly of North Carolina on March 19, 1925 and as subsequently amended, will be observed in receiving bids and awarding the General Contract.

In consideration of the Board receiving his bid, each bidder agrees that no bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled closing time for the receipt of bids for a period of 30 days. It is the intention of the Board to return all bid deposits except those of lowest bidders, within 48 hours. Bid deposits of three lowest bidders, as well as contracts have been awarded or deferred, in no event longer than 30 days.

A Performance Bond will be required in an amount equal to 100 per cent of the contract price guaranteeing the faithful performance of the contract and payment to all persons supplying labor and/or materials for the construction of the project.
