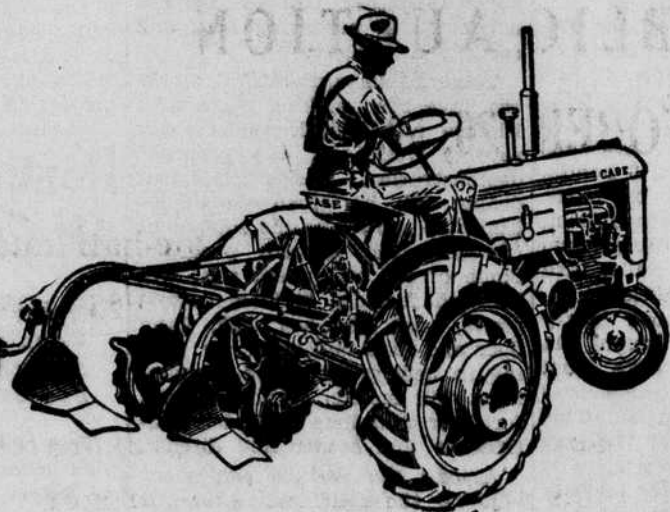

guilty to charges of possessing tax-paid whiskey and was taxed with costs.

Lester O. Milliken pleaded guilty to charges of speeding and was fined \$10.00 and costs.
