Mr. Lucey Bigford of Southport entered as a medical patient on Monday. Miss Paulette Gainey of Leland entered on Monday as a surgical patient.

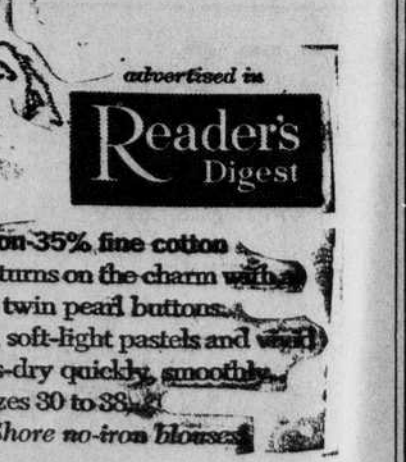

cludes destroyers, a heavy cruiser and an amphibious force of seven ships, will visit 27 cities in the seven states bordering the Great Lakes. The ships will enter the Great Lakes on June 25 and return to the Atlantic Fleet in late July. This is the first time a major fleet has been on the Great Lakes since the War of 1812.

The entry of the ocean-going fleet is made possible by the opening of the recently-completed St. Lawrence Seaway. The ships will visit the following cities and states: Illinois—Chicago; Indiana—Michigan City; Michigan—Bay City, Detroit, Marquette, Muskegon, Port Huron, Mackinaw City, Sault Ste Marie, Cheboygan; Minnesota—Duluth;

New York—Buffalo, Oswego, Rochester, Dunkirk; Ohio—Cleveland, Toledo, Lorain, Ashtabula; Penna.—Erie; Wisconsin—Waukegan, Martinette-Menominee, Sheboygan, Green Bay, Ashland.
