The rooting medium is very imease organisms, should hold moisture and at the same time provide good drainage and aeration. There are many mixtures that may be used but perhaps the simplest is equal parts, by volume, of sand and peat moss. No.

A good rule of thumb to use in determining the grade of sand is great-grandchildren.

The cuttings should be made in the early morning and kept moist in a damp cloth. Select cutlength and remove the bottom leaves. With a trowel or heavy

kitchen knift, open rows and place the cuttings in the medium so that they will not be too crowded. Press the medium to the base of the cuttings and thoroughly water.

Place the cuttings where they will have sufficient light but not in direct sunlight. The shade of a tree is good or you can provide shade with burlap. Keep moist at all times but not too wet. Protect from wind with plastic or burlap sides, or window sash, depending upon the size of your box or frame.
