

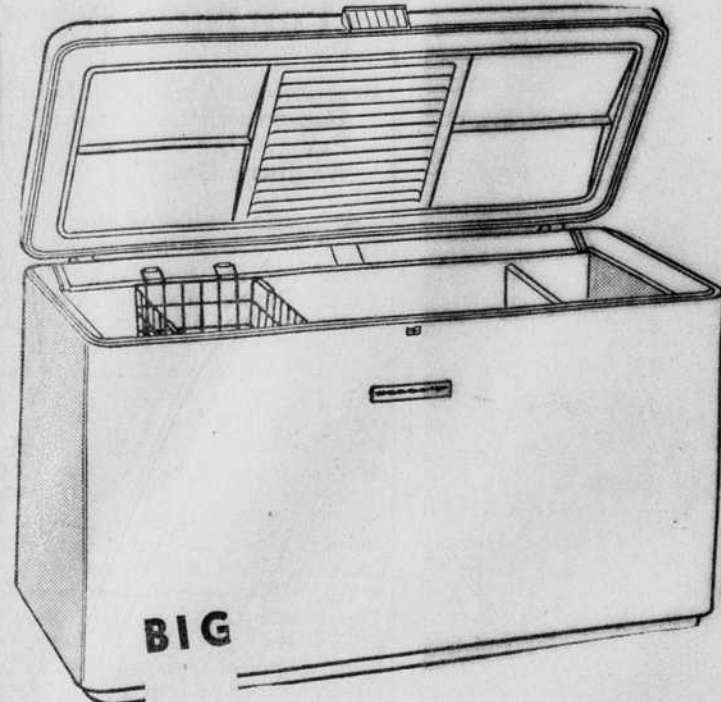
Miss Peggy Ann Russ Marries William Alton Grissett Sunday
