Another method of correcting the chlorotic condition is the use iron chelate (Key-late). Chelates are made from organic compounds and are considered to be stable and water soluble. They are effective sources of trace element Mac Jones Store, Woodburn, correction in plant nutrition. Mix the iron chelate (Sequestrene) Navassa Grocery, 11:00-11:15 a. with water according to instruction on the container. The solution can be sprayed on the plant or Leland Post Office, 12:30-1:15 sprinkled over the plants with a watering can.

In answering this question I do not wish to cause confusion because nematodes attacking the root system may also cause a cy chlorosis. In one case the nematode interferes with the absorption of all nutrients while in the other case the soil reaction makes Dubar's Station, Route 17, 2:40- the iron unavailable to the plant.


