

Eugene Fallon Attends The Writers Conference In Western North Carolina Resort

Some 70 authors gathered for the annual N. C. Writers Conference held on Friday and Saturday of last week at Blowing Rock. Attending from Southport was Eugene Fallon, member of the State Port Pilot news staff. Four sessions were held during the meet, two of which were open to the public and two of which were closed to all but participating members of the unique group

of Tar Heel writers. Perhaps the most interesting part of the program was the panel discussion held on Friday night, during which Jonathan Daniels of Raleigh; Ovid Pierce. author of "The Plantation" and 'On A Lonesome Porch"; and LeGette Blythe, former Charlotte newsman-turned-author, discussed the opportunities, hazards, helps and hindrances of writing.

In charge of this session and acting as moderator was Chalmers Davidson, professor of English at the college which bears his name. Thad Stem, Jr., Oxford poet presided during one of the closed sessions, and Julia Montgomery Street was in charge of a program designed primarily for those writing "juvenile" books.




