Grizzly Bears Wear Radios-

Idea For Bird Watchers?

National Park will soon wear miniature radios to broadcast their whereabouts to naturalists studying their habits.

Tracking the grizzlies by radio is a new development in a longrange study aimed at preventing

range study aimed at preventing their extinction. The National Geographic Society and the National Science Foundation are supporting the project.

Tiny transmitters, attached to the bears by a plastic collar, will broadcast a continuous signal over a radius of five miles or more. Directional transmitters will keep the bears' locations pinpointed despite rough terrain.


Frank and John Craighead of the Montana Cooperative Wildlife Research Unit, leaders of the study, have already developed methods for capturing the bears so that transmitters may be placed on them. The animals can be caught in steel culvert traps baited with bacon, honey, and pineapple juice. They are then injected with a harmless muscle relaxant, that keeps them from moving while a transmitter is attached.

The Craigheads also shoot bears on the loose with a special rifle that propels a harmless flying syringe which empties the relaxant into the animals.
