Southport's host Lady Dolphins opened the 1962 Brunswick County cage tournament Tuesday night, with a 45-37 victory over Bolivia's Lady Bruins, while Leland's Tiger boys swept to an 88-54 triumph over Waccamaw's Eagles in the second game of the evening.

points to pace Coach Clifford White's Lady Dolphins to their semi-finals win, while Tinkie Smith added 15 and Sally Ward had 8.

Defensively, the winners were led jointly by Pat Bartell, Frances Edwards and Patti Jenkins. Aveline Skipper of Bolivia had 25 markers to be top girl scorer of the night, while Pat Lewis was the guard of the evening for the Lady Bruins.

Coach Joe Best's Leland Tigers racking up its 24th win of the year in 27 outings, swept over Coach Tommy Shutt's Waccamaw Eagles because it had four of its five starters in double figures in the scoring column.

Nicky Gainey led with 23 points, followed by Ray Bordeaux with 18, Frankie Jacobs with 17 and Dickie Burgess with 11. Waccamaw's Eagles had their old standbys, Vernon Hughes and Lyle King as pace-setters. Hughes scored 20 points; King tallied 19.

### Two Brunswick Men Take Special Course

Rev. Mark Owens, pastor of Southport Baptist church, and Rev. Robert W. Rollins, pastor of the Baptist church of Supply, are enrolled in a six-weeks' course in pastoral care of the sick at North Carolina Baptist hospital at Winston-Salem.

The course, designed especially for working pastors, is given several times each year by the hospital's School of Pastoral Care. The present class will complete its work on March 23. ### Southport Man Is Being Held In Jail

Armon Caison, 38-year-old white man who lives near Southport, was arrested by Sheriff Ed Leonard and Deputy Drew Long Saturday morning and charged with assault upon a female with intent to commit rape. Sheriff Leonard said Caison, who is married and the father of several children, was arrested on the complaint of a young Brunswick County woman who charged that she was forcibly set upon by the defendant on the night of Washington's Birthday and that a struggle ensued which caused the plaintiff physical and mental anguish.

The defendant is being held in the Brunswick County jail in lieu of \$1,500 bond. He will be given a preliminary hearing in Recorder's Court Monday.

## Hargrove Bowles Heart Chairman

Head Of N. C. C & D Is Heading The Heart Fund Drive On State Level This Year

Hargrove Bowles, Jr., Director of the State Department of Conservation and Development, is State Chairman of the 1962 Heart Fund, according to Mrs. W. M. Sermons, Fund Raising Chairman of the Brunswick Heart Council. The appointment was announced recently by Dr. C. A long-time Heart volunteer, "Skipper" Bowles has been Treasurer and a Board member of the North Carolina Heart Association, President and a Board member of

the Greensboro Heart Association, and for two years guided the annual campaign in Greensboro. A native of Monroe, he attended the public schools there, the University of North Carolina, and the Accident and Indemnity Schools in Hartford, Connecticut.
