### Fun, games for kids at parks

Children ages six to 12, bored with summer vacation and looking for something fun to do, are invited to stop by Caviness and Franklin Square parks for games, sports, crafts, contests and field trips.

Southport Parks and Recreation Department is sponsoring free summer playground programs from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday until August 17. Annette Graham is directing the program at Caviness Park, while Briton Campbell is at Franklin Square Park.

Teenagers are welcome to participate in the programs and serve as role models for the younger children.

### May fitness campaign held

A month-long individual fitness campaign involved county residents during May.

Participants kept a daily log recording their miles bicycled, walked or run during the month. Certificates were awarded to all who participated and turned in logs. Prizes were also awarded to top-mileage athletes.

Cliff Justice of Holden Beach completed 460.3 miles bicycled and 116.1 miles run. Carolyn Norris from Holden Beach completed 211 miles in the walking category.

The program was sponsored by Brunswick County Parks and Recreation Department.

### Day camp for kids ages 6-13

The next session of summer day camp for children ages ten to 13 will be held July 13-17.

Camp sessions run from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. Activities include swimming, fishing, group games, arts and crafts, nature study, walks and field trips.

Participants will meet at the Brunswick County Government Center near Bolivia. Transportation will be provided for a variety of field trips.

The cost is \$45 a week per child and includes a T-shirt for the first week of participation. Family discounts will apply when two or more children are enrolled in day camp. An additional charge will be assessed for field trips.

A camp for children ages six to nine is scheduled July 27-31 and the last camp for children ages ten to 13 will be August 3-7. Pre-registration is required.

### Swimming classes at Caswell

Summer swimming programs will be offered for Brunswick County residents and visitors at the North Carolina Baptist Assembly pool, in cooperation with the Brunswick County Parks and Recreation Department.

The 45-minute swimming lessons are taught on a daily schedule. One-week sessions are \$25 a person. Classes are taught by American Red Cross instructors and lifeguard trainees.

The schedule is as follows: July 13-17, July 20-24, July 27-31, August 3-7. Pre-registration is required one week before the classes begin.

The following classes will be offered: 9 a.m. deep water/advanced swimmers; 10 a.m. shallow water/beginner swimmers; 11 a.m. non-swimmers, water babies and toddlers.

Transportation will be provided from the Brunswick County Government Center at Bolivia to the Fort Caswell site during the week of July 20-24. A transportation fee of \$5 will be charged in addition to the \$25 lesson fee.

The pool will be available for open swim from 9 to 11:45 a.m. Monday through Saturday. There is a \$1.50 charge.
