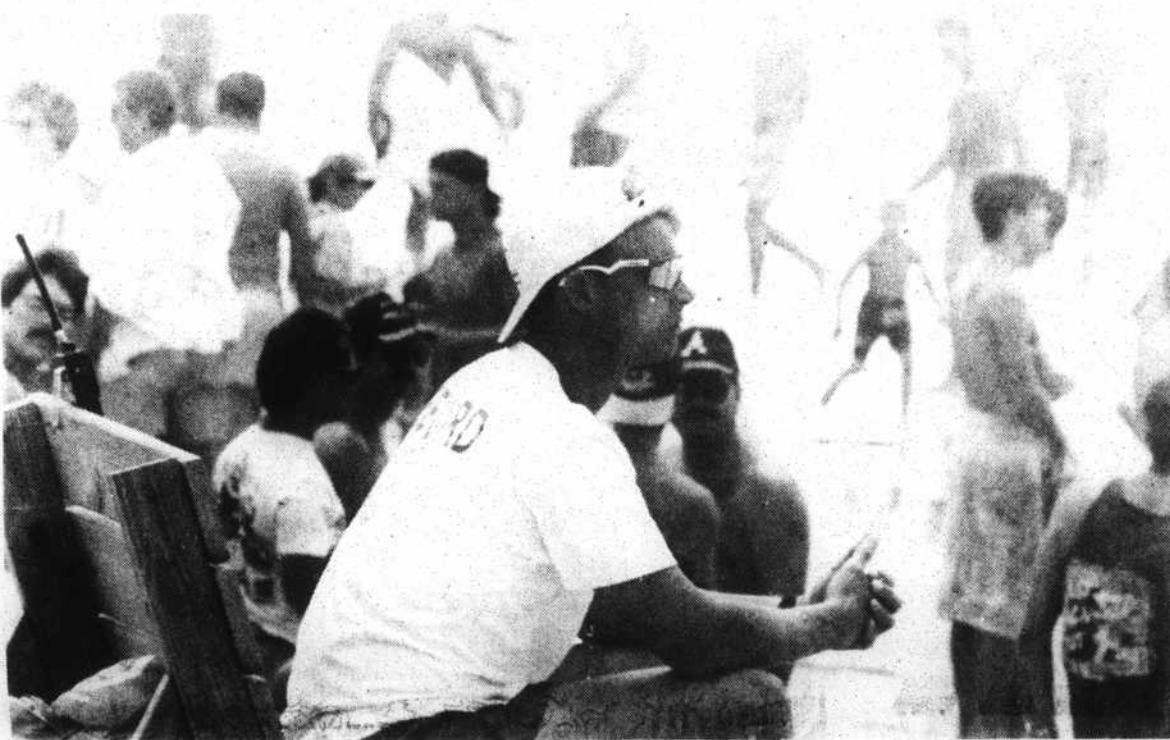




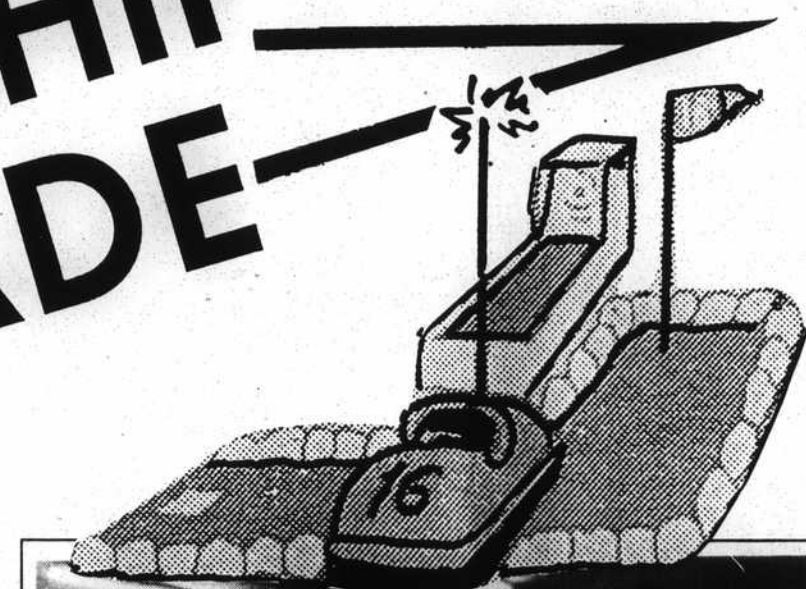
Beach Day '92

THE FLAGSHIP ARCADE



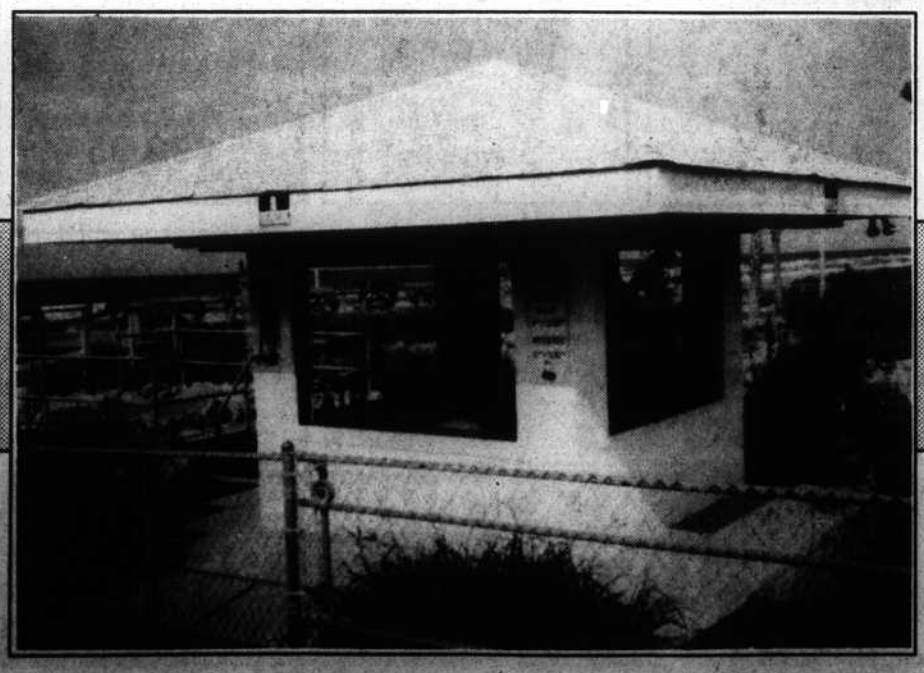
