'One-day greenhouse' nurtures BCC project

A 20-by-100-foot greenhouse will be assembled in one day on-site at Brunswick Community College's main campus Thursday, December 10.

The "one-day greenhouse" project is a cooperative effort of Sampson Community College and Brunswick Community College. About ten students from Sampson Community College's horticulture technology program, their instructors and Brunswick Community College physical plant employees will erect the greenhouse superstructure that day.

Brunswick Community College has cleared and prepared the site adjacent to the warehouse and behind the Brunswick Interagency Program building. Maintenance workers at BCC have readied for the project day by preparing the foundation and cutting, sizing and drilling receptacle pipes, said director of physical plant Curtis Workman. The supplies for the project were purchased by BCC.

Also, 130 sections of one-inch, electro-mechanical tubing were formed to specifications in the

Sampson Community College greenhouse operation class. The horticulture technology students from Sampson Community College have erected a similar structure on their campus.
