

Last 'Shop-at-Home' drawing is this week

There's just one week left to register for gifts to be awarded by area merchants in the annual "Shop at Home" campaign conducted by the Southport-Oak Island Chamber of Commerce.

"Shop at Home" is a way of rewarding residents who patronize local businesses all year long, and enticing those who may do their holiday shopping elsewhere to visit Southport-Oak Island area stores. Hundreds of dollars worth of prizes including merchandise, services and gift certificates donated by local merchants are awarded. To participate, shoppers complete entry forms to be eligible for prizes. Winners are randomly selected from all entries received at weekly drawings. The last drawing is scheduled for December 21 at the chamber of commerce office.

Entries can be dropped off at boxes located at most participating businesses. The winners are listed in *The State Port Pilot* and will be officially notified in writing by the chamber of commerce, which sponsors "Shop at Home" in conjunction with the Christmas-By-the-Sea Festival.

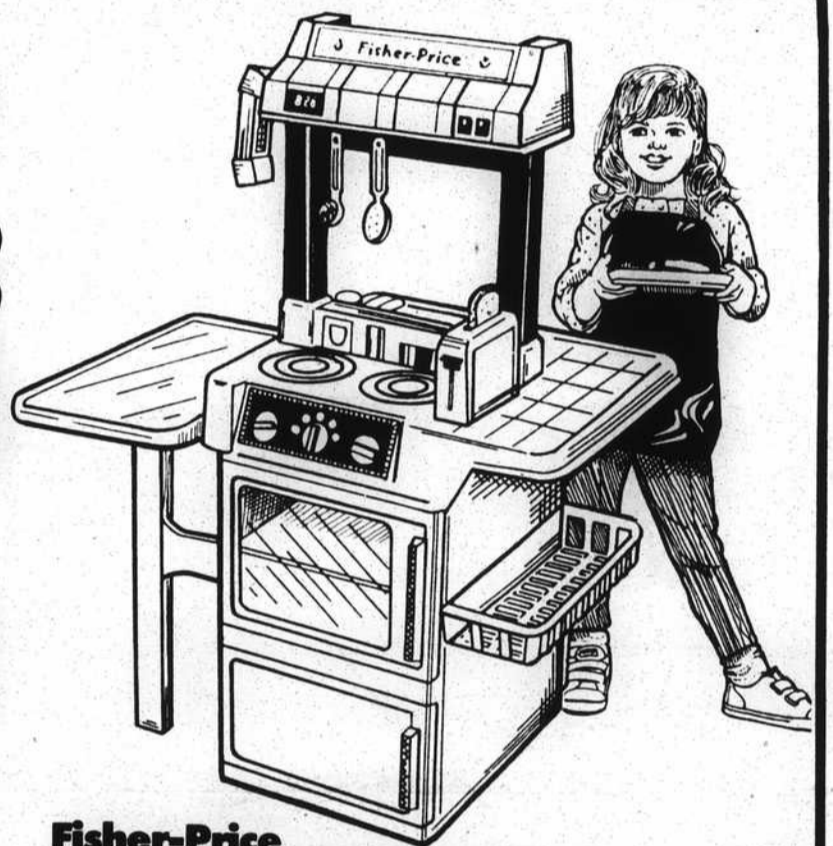

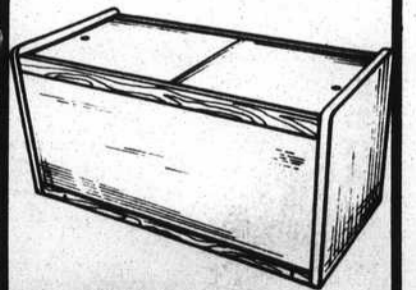
