PAYMENT

Advertisements mailed or brought to the newspaper, should be paid upon placement of the ad. How to write a good classified ad

3. Keep abbreviations to a minimum - make it easy for readers to understand.

4. Place yourself in the reader's position - ask what you would like to know about the merchandise for sale - include information such as brand names, colors and other specific descriptions.


