CHARLOTTE -- Former North Brunswick head football coach Clark Harrell, whose one Scorpion team will be remembered for its excellent defensive play, was named head football coach at 4A Charlotte Harding High School on Thursday, The Charlotte Observer reported.

Charlotte Harding, a perennial power in the 1950s under legendary coach Dave Harris, played for the state championship eight years ago against Garner when the Rams were under the direction of Bruce Hardin.

Hardin then moved to West Charlotte to establish a 4A power before going to 3A Kannapolis Brown, where he coached against Harrell the past two seasons when he was at Sun Valley High near Monroe.


