

# Former Scorps coach Harrell takes Charlotte grid position

**CHARLOTTE** -- Former North Brunswick head football coach Clark Harrell, whose one Scorpion team will be remembered for its excellent defensive play, was named head football coach at 4A Charlotte Harding High School on Thursday, *The Charlotte Observer* reported.

Charlotte Harding, a perennial power in the 1950s under legendary coach Dave Harris, played for the state championship eight years ago against Garner when the Rams were under the direction of Bruce Hardin.

Hardin then moved to West Charlotte to establish a 4A power before going to 3A Kannapolis Brown, where he coached against Harrell the past two seasons when he was at Sun Valley High near Monroe.

Harrell, who played linebacker at

East Carolina University under former Pirate and Auburn coach Pat Dye from 1975-79, got his start at 1A Columbia High in 1984-85 before moving to North Brunswick for one season. He then went to 3A Bartlett Yancey until 1988 before taking the Wilson Beddingfield job. Then he moved to Sun Valley High as head football coach and athletic director.

A good friend and pupil of West Brunswick head coach Jim Brett, Harrell said he had finally reached his goal of coaching a potential 4A state champion.

After looking at the Harding films of last season, Harrell was impressed with the team's speed and promise.

"I can see some real potential, especially with that speed," he said. Harrell, whose 3-7 North Bruns-

wick team was in practically every game his lone season with the Scorpions until the final five minutes, losing to West Brunswick in overtime and to South Brunswick by a single point, will be heading a program with no travel problems. All of the Rams' games are within short driving distance.

The new coach credited Hardin, along with Brett and Jim Washburn, defensive coordinator with the Charlotte Rage, as being instrumental in his appointment.

Brunswick County schools' athletic director Nelson Best said he was happy with Harrell's appointment.

"He did an outstanding job at North Brunswick on defense with below average talent that year," Best said. "He's a real good defensive coach."


