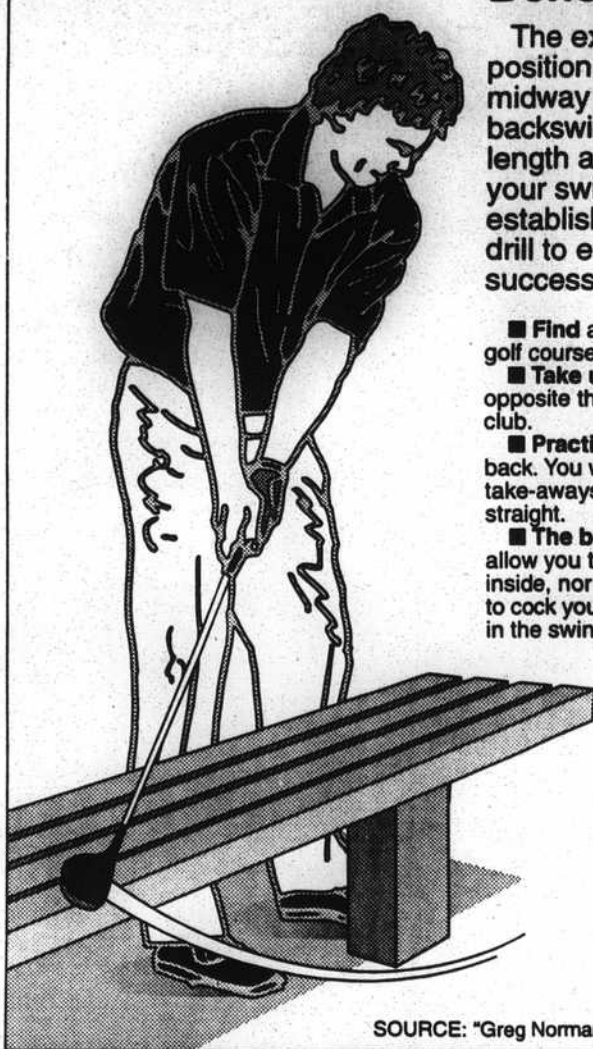


TEEING OFF



Bench work

The extension position is a point midway through the backswing where the length and power of your swing arc is established. Try this drill to ensure success.

- Find a bench on the golf course.
- Take up your stance opposite the side of your club.
- Practice the take-back. You will discover your take-aways must be straight.
- The bench will not allow you to pull to the inside, nor will it allow you to cock your wrists too soon in the swing.
