# Colors all year

When designing or adding to your landscape, think about providing seasonal interest, such as bloom color, bark eye-catchers and berries. Consult your nursery about foliage, bloom color, berries, fragrance and growing requirements such as hardiness, sunlight, drainage and soil type (ph).

Listed below are a few shrubs, vines and trees which will give you color you can look forward to each month of the year along with your bulbs, perennials and annuals. Colors are: P (pink), R (red), W (white), L (lavender), Y (yellow), V (varied).

- January-February -- Camellia Japonica, V.
- January-March -- Winter Daphne, R, W; Flowering Quince,
- February-March -- Forsythia, Y; Redbud, R. P. W.
- March-April -- Flowering Almond or Cherry, P, W; Spirea, P,

W; Wisteria, W, L; Dogwood, R, P,

- April-early May -- Hawthorn, P. W; Mountain Laurel, R, P, W; Viburnum, W, L; Azalea, V
- May -- Weigela, R, P; Mock Orange, P, W; Clematis, V; ■ May-June - Magnolia, W;
- Rose, V. May-July -- Abelia, W,P.
- June -- Cape Jasmine, W; Rose of Sharon, V.
- June-August -- Oleander, R,P,
- W; Hydrangea, V. ■ July-frost - Crape Myrtle, V;
- Buddleia, W. ■ September-October -- Osman-
- November-December -- Confederate Rose, R, P, W; Camellia

Sasanqua, P, W. Bloom time may vary in mountain, piedmont and coastal areas.

Berried plants to brighten your landscape and attract birds are: Pyracantha, Holly, Beautyberry, Contoneaster, Mahonia and Nandina. Birds will love these.
