The high cost of playing ball

Outfitting a team is no cheap measure for high school athletics

In the dead of winter, before baseball practice begins and the boys of summer take to the diamond, North Brunswick head coach Wes Coward pushes a cart filled with candy bars and potato chips to the school courtyard.

It's one way for the coach to raise extra funds for his baseball team, selling snacks to students during the ten-minute break. With five spring sports programs to fund on a tight high school athletic department budget, there is not enough money allocated to each team so coaches can develop their own wish list.


Outfitting one player -- taking into consideration bats, baseballs and other accessories the whole team might use :- can run as high as \$1,080 each. Multiply that by a team of 14 varsity players and two coaches and you have an expensive program that does not generate such revenues at the gate through ticket sales. Money comes from the county and school athletic booster clubs.

When it comes to outfitting baseball players, costs vary for pitchers, catchers or outfielders and infielders. The most expensive uniform is worn by the catcher, who needs an estimated \$176 more in protective gear (well worth the price tag) than the average player along with a special hinged-back mitt that costs \$169.95 at wholesale.

A Rawlings Pro Series 11" glove runs \$149.95 for pitchers and other players. The basic Nike spike shoes cost \$75.99 a pair for all players. The next time you see a foul ball carry out of play, lost in the woods, it represents \$48.99 per dozen for the Diamond D-1 Pro baseballs.

This season, North Brunswick will wear new pinstripe uniforms that cost \$109 a set. Multiply that by 14 players and two coaches and you get a bill for \$1,764 for jerseys, subject to rips and tears from sliding home for a score.

They do not last forever. In a couple of years, it'll be time for new uniforms and the cycle starts over again. Keeping players and teams


