High authorities have neve quite agreed as to the severity o by the similar business conclusi ons of other years, especially 1893 and 1873. Some have maintained that the strain was more sever two years ago than it ever wa before, but the majority of those who have passed judgement on the question hold that the panic of 1907 was less serious than the crashes in 1857, 1873 and 1893 All have agreed that several mark ed differences had to be taken into account, and that comparison But now therespects easy. But now there is no room for less than two state of thing less than two years after the indurstry and in the security markets and resources and busi markets and resources and busied than it was twice as far from the crisis in 1893 or the earlier financial convulsion in 1873. Six years, in the later case, and five years in the depression following the panic of 1893, did not bring such record breaking prices for some important securities as has been scored within the last few
weeks. Nor was there such demand for labor, three times a far from the crisis of 1893, as there is now.
By the test of the labor mar et the panic of 1907 was no nearly so long and difficult to re cover from as either of the two great business convulsions which Weighed by its con weighed by its efects upon the wage-eand easy was relatively that after all, is about the best that after all, is about the best
test which can be applied. The recovery of trade and productive industries from the depression in to which the panic plunged the markably swift and complete and the workers are reaping their share of the benefits.
