GENERAL NEWS ITEMS

The North Carolina Grand Lodge of Masons took part in the funeral of the late Maj. Lee D. Heartt, who died at his home at Greensboro last Friday night.

The State of Kentucky has collected \$2,000 in inheritance taxes on the estate of the late Mrs. Robert Worth Bingham.

Nearly eleven thousand men were enlisted last Wednesday at Washington for the regular army and reports show an additional 2,000 came in too late for tabulation.

Last Friday it was ordered by the fuel administration that Washington should have two lightless nights a week.

After December 16 Southern trains will operate Pullman cars only as far east as Washington.

The nation's drink bill approximated \$2,000,000,000 during the fiscal year ended June 30, 1917. Of this amount consumers of whiskey and other distilled spirits contributed \$1,208,884,768.

A general priority order, giving preferential shipment to food, fuel and government supplies was issued last Friday by R. S. Lovett, government director of priority transportation.

The North Carolina Baptist conference elected Goldsboro as their meeting place next year. The conference asked for \$10,000 for religious work at camps.

T. G. McAlister, of Fayetteville, who is superintendent of roads and bridges of Cumberland county, has resigned from that position.
