

Well, I am feeling the best I have in a long time but I am not working so hard now and I hope I won't have to go more while I am over here. I think our hardest work is over. Well, mother, you make about the car ride, how would you have enjoyed yourself had I been along? Well, how it would have been with me. Well, this is Sunday and eight of us boys have just got back from a long stroll in the country. I suppose we went seven or eight miles and we never saw but one old house and no one lived in it, and we went up on the top of a mountain and there were lots of deer and wild hares, two deer came running through the woods toward us and one ran by us and the other turned back but soon came on the trail of the other, and we ran after it and threw clubs at it. They sure can go yonder. I don't think there is any rabbit around here.
