The census bureau reports the largest cotton crop since 1914 grown in the country last year. Final ginning reports show 13,618,751 bales, which is larger than the 1923 crop by 3,479,080 bales. Of this bumper crop North Carolina produced 823,278 bales as against a million in 1923.

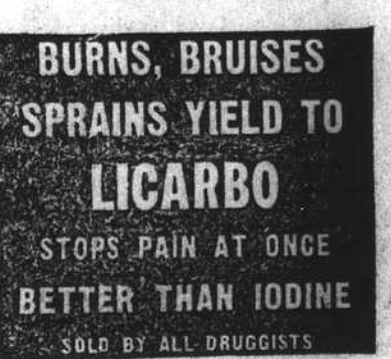
