HE SOUGHT THE Soul OF MAN.



ON of a professor of law, Gottfried Wilhelm von Leibnitz only naturally directed his studies in that profession. He was born in Leipzig, Germany, in 1646, and qualified for his law degree a year before he could get it legally. Immediately he set out to reform the

'Corpus Juris," or body of the law. But his interest quickly veered toward a search for the source of man's soul, and an effort to explain God's trust in man. Out of this came Leibnitz's basic philosophy, that the soul, like all the senses of man, was born with a person, and that it is the consciousness of its presence that is acquired later by education and experience.

In mathematics, as in philosophy and law, Leibnitz became world famous. He improved and added to the study of calculus, or the mathematics of reasoning, and to analytical geometry. In 1700, he became chief organizer and first president of the Berlin Academy of Sciences. He died, in 1716, at the age of 70



years. Germany, in 1926, included his portrait on one of a series of stamps honoring its famous sons. It is shown here.


