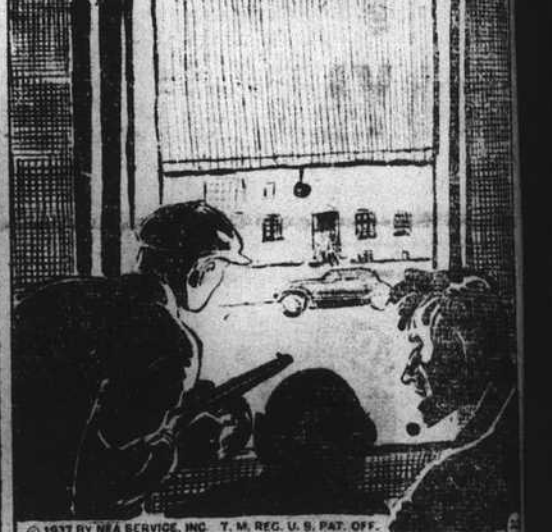
in the group. The principal, associate teachers, students, and patrons in the community are loathe to give her up.
